
LESSON PLAN

Age	12-13 yrs old
Level	A2 pre-intermediate
Торіс	United in diversity: the European Union
Aims	 To learn the main characteristics of European Union using the terms of the English language To use the acquired knowledge to answer questions about the fundamental rights of every individual in the European Union To learn and use some terms pertaining the European Union
Time	1 hr
Materials	 Geography Book, "Geoprotagonisti. L'Europa e i suoi stati". Digital Geography Book IWB Pc Internet connection
Procedure	Teacher resumes the steps of the origins of the European
Step 1	Union, previously studied in Italian, using maps in text-book.
Step 2	Using a mind map on IWB, teacher explains the main institutions of the European Union and their locations.
Step 3	<u>Activity 1 :</u> - Students do a set of exercises like these:
	Complete the text with the following words:
	COUNTRIES, PEACE, ORGANIZATION, SECURITY.



	 The single currency is called the Euro, and its symbol is €.
	New words that students will learn are SHAPE, ANTHEM, SINGLE CURRENCY.
	 Teacher monitors students to make sure they are doing the exercises correctly.
Step 5	Activiy 3:
	 Students use their knowledge to answer to those questions:
	"What is illustrated on the Italian 1 euro coin?"
	 Students compare their answers with those of their classmates.
Step 6	- <u>Activity 4:</u>
	- Teacher reads the following text in the text-book:
	<u>The Charter of Fundamental Rights lists the rights of every</u> <u>individual in the European Union: civil, political, economic and</u> <u>social rights. It also contains the values of the European</u> <u>Union. They are:</u>
	DIGNITY, EQUALITY
	Students complete the text, refering to their textbook if necessary.
