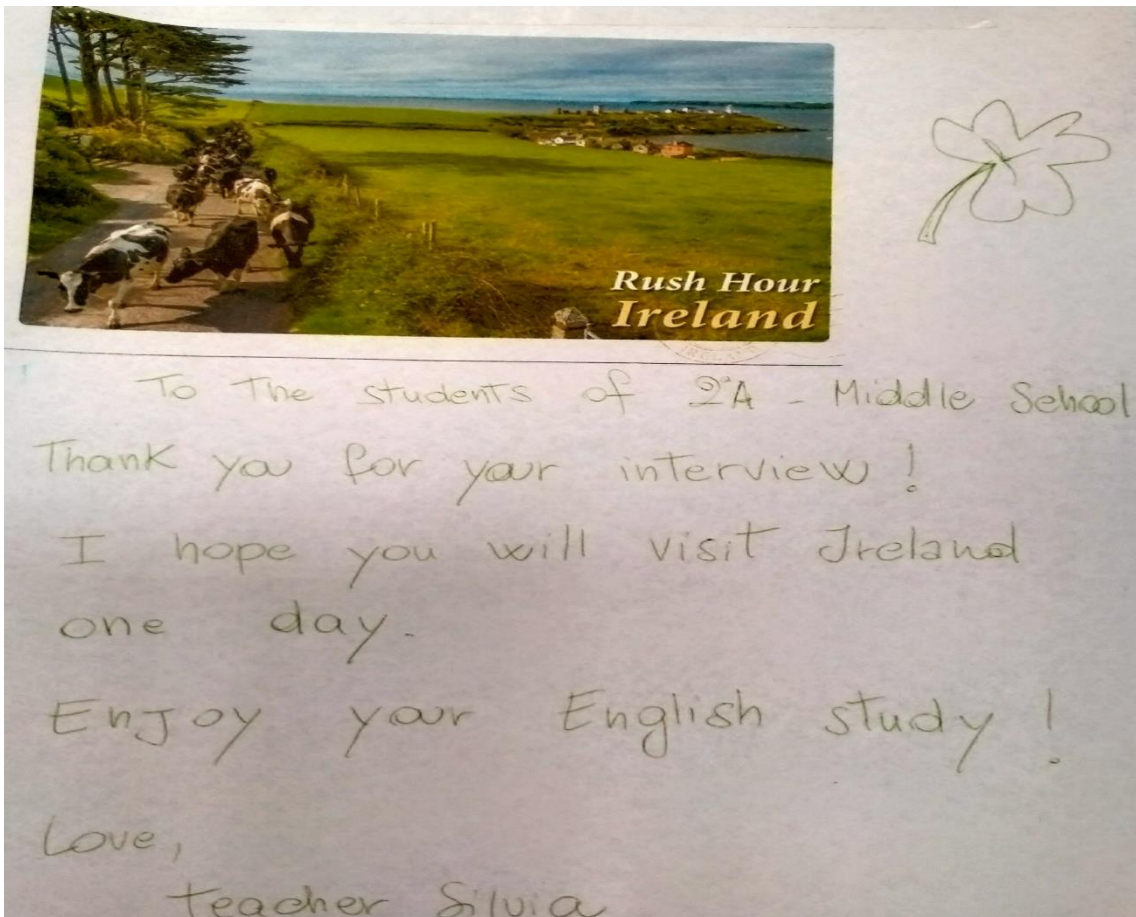

HER ANSWERS

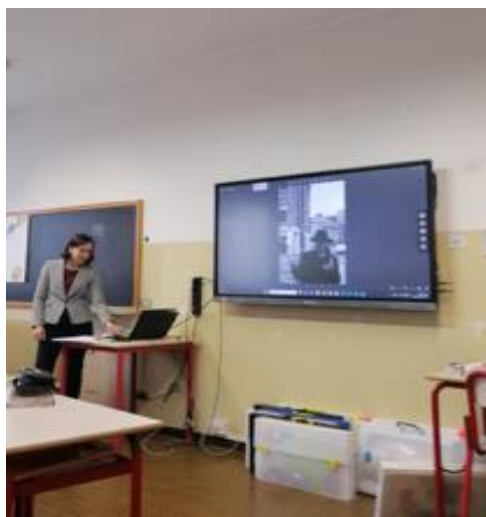
- 1 She really liked her group
